Subject: **NCOC Decisions and NPIs**  
 NCOC session dated **9<sup>th</sup> June 2021** reference.

1. **NCOC session** chaired by **Mr Asad Umer (Federal Minister for Planning, Development, Reforms and Special Initiatives)** was held on **9 June 2021**. A detailed review of current **disease situation** in the country and corresponding NPIs was carried out. Forum agreed on implementation of following NPIs / decisions as per dates mentioned against each:-

Ser	Sector	NPIs	With Effect From / Remarks
<b>NPIs Continue to Remain Enforced</b>			
a.	<b>Extended Lockdowns</b>	<b>Broader lockdowns</b> with stringent enforcement protocols based on risk assessment will continue. NCOC will regularly share heat maps with federating units for implementation of lockdowns.	<b>Status quo will be maintained</b>
b.	<b>Gatherings</b>	<b>Ban on all types of indoor / outdoor gatherings</b> including cultural, musical / religious / miscellaneous events <b>will continue</b> .	
c.	<b>Religious</b>	Closure of Shrines will continue.	
d.	<b>Cinemas</b>	Closure of Cinemas will continue.	
e.	<b>Sports</b>	<b>Continuation of ban</b> on contact sports (Karate, Boxing, Martial Arts, Rugby, Water Polo, Kabaddi & Wrestling), festivals, cultural and other events.	
f.	<b>Railways</b>	<b>Railway will continue</b> operations at <b>70% capacity</b> .	
g.	<b>Business Timings</b>	Resumption of market activities with closure by <b>08:00 pm</b> (less essential services i.e Petrol Pumps, Pharmacies / Medical Facilities, Vaccination Canter, Milk / Dahi Shops, Tandoors and Takeaways).	
h.	<b>Dining</b>	<b>Complete ban on indoor dining will continue</b> ; however, outdoor dining is allowed till 11:59 pm (Including all types of food courts in Malls). Takeaways are allowed 24/7.	
i.	<b>Marriages</b>	<b>Ban on all types of indoor marriages / functions. Outdoor marriages allowed</b> with maximum <b>150 x guests</b> with strict COVID SOPs. Wedding hall association will assume responsibilities for SOPs compliance.	
j.	<b>Land Borders Policy</b>	<b>Current Land Border Policy arrangements will continue</b> till further orders.	
k.	<b>Mask Wearing</b>	<b>Compliance to compulsory mask wearing</b> by all federating units while incorporating innovative measures for enforcement.	

2. Revised NPIs are as under:-

Ser	Sector	NPIs	With Effect From / Remarks
a.	<b>Closed Days</b>	<b>1 x day will be observed as closed day</b> during a week. <b>(choice of closed day will be as per discretion of federating units)</b> . Exemptions to essential services only i.e Grocery Stores, Bakeries, Sweet Shops, Vegetable / Fruit Shops, Chicken / Meat Shops.	<b>15-30 June 21</b>
b.	<b>Office Routine</b>	Resumption of normal working hours for public / private offices with <b>100 % attendance</b> .	

Ser	Sector	NPIs	With Effect From / Remarks
c.	<b>Public Transport</b>	Resumption of all types of public transport with <b>increased occupancy from 50% to 70%.</b>	<b>15-30 June 21</b>
d.	<b>Ban on inter provincial Public Transport</b>	<b>2 days ban on inter provincial public transport imposed on mid night 9/10 April 2021 has been lifted.</b>	
e.	<b>Gyms</b>	<b>Reopening of indoor Gyms only for vaccinated individuals / members. Mandatory vaccination of Gym staff / management will be sole responsibility of owner.</b>	
f.	<b>Inbound Passenger Policy</b>	<b>Current Inbound Passengers Policy arrangements will continue</b> till further orders. List of Category C countries will be issued separately.	

- All NPIs mentioned above will remain enforced from **15<sup>th</sup> June till 30<sup>th</sup> June 21**, review will be carried out at NCOC on **28 June 21**. Any further relaxation in NPIs (as and when decided) will be linked with vaccination.
- A critical monitoring of disease prevalence / critical health care system is being carried out by NCOC on daily basis and necessary decisions will be taken accordingly whenever deemed appropriate to control the disease spread.
- All concerned are requested to issue notifications at priority and dissemination to all concerned, please.
